

## ## Using apt-cacher

It depends on template. Please refer to template help. Usually template supports MIRROR and SECURITY\_MIRROR environment variable or `--mirror` and `--security-mirror` param.

If mirrors are set, template will use mirror during installation and also container apt configuration will be set to use mirrors. See examples below:

For Ubuntu you can work around this by editing `/etc/default/lxc` and setting

```
MIRROR="http://192.168.0.231:3142/archive.ubuntu.com/ubuntu"  
MIRROR="http://192.168.0.231:3142/debian"  
SECURITY_MIRROR="http://192.168.0.231:3142/debian" lxc-create -n debian2 -t  
debian
```
